The Subcommittee deliberated (index of proceedings attached at **Annex**).

- 2. In response to the request of the Subcommittee raised at the last meeting on 19 October 2010, the Administration had submitted for members' consideration its proposed amendments to the Port Control (Public Cargo Working Area) Order 2010 (the Order) to stipulate that the revised boundary of the Western District Public Cargo Working Area (PCWA) excluding a site of 7 500 square meters for temporary use as a barging point would only be effective between 13 November 2010 and 31 December 2014 (both dates inclusive). The original boundary of the Western District PCWA would be restored on 1 January 2015. Regarding the Chinese version of the Administration's proposed amendments to sections 3 and 4 of the Schedule, Assistant Legal Advisor 3 (ALA3) suggested that the drafting of the provisions could be improved by replacing "暫時撤銷" with "暫停實施" as the Chinese rendition of the words "suspension" and "suspended". agreed to ALA3's suggestion.
- 3. <u>The Subcommittee</u> noted a letter dated 25 October 2010 from the Chairman of Central & Western District Council (C&WDC) expressing concern about the traffic and environmental impacts of the transportation arrangements arising from the modification works for the Admiralty Station, and the Administration's response to the questions raised in that letter. <u>The Administration</u> further advised that in addition to previous consultation with C&WDC, a further meeting with C&WDC had been scheduled for 2 November 2010 to explain the detailed arrangements and measures that would be taken to minimize impact on the local residents. <u>The Administration undertook to keep C&WDC posted of the developments</u>.

(*Post-meeting note:* The draft minutes of the meeting of C&WDC held on 2 November 2010 was issued vide LC Paper No. CB(1)376/10-11(01) on 8 November 2010.)

4. <u>Mr KAM Nai-wai</u> asked to put on record his objection to the setup of a temporary material stockpile area at the barging point which in his view might pose dust nuisance to residents nearby.

Clause-by-clause examination of the Order

5. <u>The Subcommittee</u> conducted clause-by-clause examination of the Order.

Admin 6. After discussion, the Administration was requested to –

- (a) revise its proposed amendments in the light of ALA3's comments referred to in paragraph 2 above;
- (i.e. in the Loose-leaf edition, by replacement page; and in the Bilingual Laws Information System, by updating the section module) of the Port Control (Public Cargo Working Area) (Consolidation) Order (Cap. 81 sub. leg. B) ("the Consolidation Order") to remind users that section 7 of the Consolidation Order referring to the original boundary of the Western District PCWA was being suspended from 13 November 2010 until the beginning of 1 January 2015;

(*Post-meeting note:* A paper on the revised proposed amendments and the Administration's undertaking to follow up on item (b) above was issued vide LC Paper No. CB(1)295/10-11(01) on 2 November 2010.)

- (c) respond to a member's request for provision of 24-hour hotline service for matters arising from the operation of the temporary barging point; and
- (d) provide a plan and side elevations of the temporary barging point.

(*Post-meeting note:* The supplementary information provided by the Administration on items (c) and (d) above was issued vide LC Paper No. CB(1)377/10-11(01)-(02) on 8 November 2010.)

<u>Members</u> agreed that the revised amendments and supplementary information to be provided by the Administration would be circulated to members when available. <u>Members</u> also agreed that there was no need to hold a further meeting.

7. <u>The Subcommittee</u> completed scrutiny of the Order and agreed to report its deliberations to the House Committee (HC) at its meeting on 5 November 2010. <u>Members</u> noted that the Secretary for Transport and Housing would move a motion to amend the Order at the Council meeting on 10 November 2010. <u>The Chairman</u> advised that the scrutiny period of the Order would expire on 10 November 2010, and that the deadline for giving notice of motion to amend the Order was 3 November 2010.
