Tung Chung Safe and Healthy City (Community Services) Foundation Limited is a non-profit-making organization, which was formerly set up in 2005 as the Steering Committee of the Tung Chung Safe and Healthy City. In the past 5 years, with the effort of 24 stackholders from local resident, commercial and government sectors, the organisation was actively collaborated with the local District Council, government departments, commercial organizations, NGOs, schools and community organizations to encourage positive livelihood and building up a harmonious community culture through publicity, education and training activities.

Aim of the Plan:
