## Criminal Legal Aid Fees

I refer to your open letter of 16 September 2009 to the Secretary for Home Affairs in respect of the Review of Criminal Legal Aid Fees．

The Government is committed to providing reasonable and effective remuneration for legal aid lawyers within the remits of public affordability．During our discussion with the profession on the review of the fee system since 2006，we share the view of the legal profession that the criminal legal aid fee system has room for enhancement and we have taken on board many of the profession＇s suggestions．

The Government's move to increase the criminal legal aid expenditure by about $\$ 100$ million (which would increase the remuneration of solicitors by $120 \%$ to $400 \%$, depending on individual cases) is the best possible package to enhance remuneration of solicitors engaged in the provision of this very important service.

We would proceed to make preparations for the legislative process to effect the new system and new fees, in the hope that a consensus can be reached. We appeal to the legal profession for continued support to provide effective legal aid services to the public.
