It has been brought to my attention that the following building works have been carried out in or at the above premises:

- (i) A shopfront extension erected on the external wall at the front at G/F;
- (ii) A Structure together with canopy(ies) on and over the rear yard at G/F; and
- (iii) Door opening formed in the front escape staircase enclosure wall at cockloft level.
- 2. For the said building works:
 - (a) The building works at item (i) and (ii) above have been carried out with out having first obtained from me the approval of building plans and consent for the commencement of such building works required by Section 14 of the Buildings Ordinance; and
 - (b) As a result of the building works at Items (iii) above, Regulation 90 of the Building (Construction) Regulations, which requires the building to be designed and constructed so as to inhibit or provide adequate resistance to the spread of fire and smoke; and to maintain stability of the building in case of fire, has been contravened.
- 3. In exercise of the powers vested in me under section 24(1) of the Buildings Ordinance, I hereby order you to:-
 - (a) demolish the said building works described under items (i) and (ii) above; and
 - (b) reinstate the parts of the building so affected by the building works under item (iii) above in accordance with the plans approved by the Building Authority.

Adequate precautionary measures to ensure public safety should be provided prior to and during the course of works.

- 4. You are required to commence the works ordered by me in paragraph 3 above within 30 days and complete such works within 60 days of the date of this order, all to the satisfaction of the Building Authority.
- 5. Section 46 of the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance (Cap. 1) provides, inter alia, that where any Ordinance confers power upon any person to make any order, such power shall include power to substitute another order for the one already made. Pursuant to that section, the Building Authority who is empowered under section 24(1) of the Buildings Ordinance (Cap. 123) to make the previous order i.e. Order No. UBZ/U27-22/0001/04 dated 8 November 2005 is also empowered to make this order which substitutes the previous order.

- Remove loose, cracked or otherwise defective concrete from the reinforced concrete structure of the building, clean existing exposed steel bars of loose rust and foreign matter, provide and securely fix in place additional steel bars as necessary and reinstate. New concrete is not to be placed prior to inspection by the Building Authority; and
- 2. Remove all loose or defective external and internal wall finishes.

All works specified in this order shall be carried out to such standard acceptable to the Building Authority and in compliance with the regulations.
