Tariff adjustment of The Hong Kong & China Gas Co Ltd (Towngas)

Requested information

(a) Impact of the plan of Towngas to raise basic tariff on the commercial customers, especially the small and medium enterprises

Based on the average gas consumption in 2009, Towngas estimates that 50% of the commercial and industrial customers, especially the small and medium enterprises, would pay less than \$144 extra for their gas supply each month.

The average increase of the commercial and industrial customers will be about \$411 each month.

(b) Financial statements for the years 2005-2006, 2007-2008 and 2008-2009, in particular in respect of the items leading to rising operating costs, with detailed breakdown for each of the items

1. Source of Information

Towngas is a company listed in Hong Kong and in general its financial information is released to the public in the Interim Report, the Annual Report and related preliminary results announcements. The financial statements, notes to the accounts providing further breakdowns and related disclosures are prepared in accordance with the Hong Kong Financial Reporting Standards issued by Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants, Hong Kong Companies Ordinance and Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited ("Listing Rules"). In accordance with the Listing Rules, Towngas being a listed company, is required to ensure the information disclosure should be fair and consistent to parties concerned. In view of good corporate governance practice, it is difficult for the company to release unpublished financial information to any specific party selectively.

3. Supplementary Information

3.A Rising costs - higher pipe and rental expenses

Cost comparison for pipe and rental expenses (index : year 2005=100) are as follows :

3.B Increasing capital expenditure - from HK\$4.4 Billion (2005-2009) to HK\$4.9 Billion (2010-2014)

In order to support the development of Hong Kong and to maintain gas supply reliability, capital expenditure amounted to HK\$4.9 Billion will be spent in the next five years (2010-2014). Major projects are highlighted below:

(a) <u>Transmission Projects</u>

To cope with the government's Tolo Highway Widening Project, the existing high pressure pipeline is affected and about 2.5km long pipeline will be constructed from 2009 to 2013 for the necessary diversion work.

(b) <u>Distribution Projects</u>

• Natural Gas Pipeline Project

A Natural Gas pipeline from Tai Po to Ma Tau Kok Gas Production Plant will be constructed to provide natural gas as feedstock for gas production in the Plant.

• Medium Pressure Pipelines

To reinforce the town gas supply security in the New Territories, the Tuen Mun Loop Project will be undertaken to construct a 9km steel pipeline linking the current Tuen Mun and Tai Lam off-take stations.

In addition, to cope with the government's massive Kai Tak Development and Cruise Terminal project and also Highways Department's Central Kowloon Route project, relocation of existing submarine pipelines from Ma Tau Kok to North Point is required and will be completed in 2014.

Furthermore, there are also other medium pressure pipeline diversion projects to cope with the infrastructure development/enhancement projects.

• Normal Pipeline Maintenance Program

Regular replacement of aging distribution pipelines to enhance safety and reliability of the town gas supply network is required.
