 - (d) Public rental housing for single persons;
 - (e) Rent review; and
 - (f) Asset enhancement initiatives by The Link Real Estate Investment Trust.
- 10. The <u>Chairman</u> reminded members of the special meeting to be held on Friday, 23 October 2009, at 4:30 pm, to receive a briefing from the Secretary for Transport and Housing on the relevant policy initiatives in the Chief Executive's Policy Address 2009-2010.
