Progress Report on the Addition of Lifts and Escalators in Housing Authority's Existing Public Rental Housing Estates

PURPOSE

This paper aims to brief Members on the progress of the programme for adding lifts, escalators and footbridges in the Housing Authority's (HA) existing public rental housing (PRH) estates.

BACKGROUND

2. At the Legislative Council Panel on Housing meeting in January 2009, Members were briefed on our plan to enhance the pedestrian access in identified PRH estates to cater for the need of PRH tenants in using barrier-free access, in particular the elderly and the disabled. We will provide new lifts, escalators and footbridges in external areas of PRH blocks within estate boundaries to connect elevated platforms with large-level differences. Where technically feasible, we will also add lift towers in existing PRH blocks which were built without lift These two projects will cost around \$450 million and the programme is service. Under an on-going lift modernisation targeted for completion by 2012. programme, we will continue to modernise aged lifts of over 25 years which are currently in use, and take the opportunity to provide lift openings for floors now without such opening where the structure permits. The programme aims at replacing about 100 lifts each year over the next five years with a total estimated expenditure of \$500 million.

3. At the meeting, Members has requested the Administration to provide progress report on the implementation programme. An update on the progress is as follows–

PROGRESS UPDATE

(A) Addition of Lifts, Escalators and Footbridges in External Areas

4. These projects in external areas within PRH estate boundaries are on schedule with details as set out at **Annex I.** In summary, we have completed the addition of lifts and footbridges in Kwai Chung Estate (except for the one near Block 4), Sai Wan Estate and Kwai Shing East Estate while construction work is underway for two PRH estates. Design work is being conducted in 15 PRH estates and feasibility study is being carried out in another estate.

(B) Addition of Lifts in Existing PRH Blocks Without Lift Service

5. Projects are moving ahead as planned and details are set out at **Annex II**. We have completed adding lift towers in Tai Hing Estate. Construction works in Yue Wan Estate, Block 4 of Lek Muk Shue (II) Estate and Shui Pin Wai Estate are in progress. The project at Choi Hung Estate is now being tendered. We are now conducting the design work for 22 PRH blocks in 7 estates and feasibility study in the remaining 4 PRH blocks in 2 estates.

(C) Modernisation Work for Lifts in Existing PRH Estates

6. Since early 2009, we have awarded eight lift modernisation contracts involving 124 lifts in 8 PRH estates. They will be completed in phases in the next 3 years.

USE OF NEW TECHNOLOGY

7. The "Prefabricated steel lift tower construction" method and machine-room-less lift will be suitably adopted to enable the use of shallow foundations in order to minimise construction time. The HA will continue to explore new technologies in an attempt to shorten the construction time of new lift towers and minimise possible nuisance to tenants.

8. Members are invited to note the progress report on the addition of lifts, escalators and footbridges in HA's existing PRH estates.
