## International ccTLD domain name for .HK (.香港)

The recent ICANN meeting held in Seoul has resolved technical and administrative issues for Fast Track IDN ccTLD names and laid down the schedule of introduction of some IDN ccTLDs. In this regard, I am writing to seek your sponsorship and endorsement for the Hong Kong Internet Service Providers Association to bid for the administration of ".香港"

The current ASCII ccTLD for Hong Kong ".hk" is being operated by HKIRC. As evident from past experiences in the domain name market space, competition generally will bring better service to domain name users, and competition itself brings cross-benchmarking for mutual service improvements. In this regard, the HKISPA believes that riding on this new development, the delegation of the new IDN ccTLD ".香港" should be open for competition. This would create best economic benefit for Hong Kong and improves the positive perception of domain name users on the openness of Hong Kong's ICT policies.


