

**L.N. 16 of 2010****SMOKING (PUBLIC HEALTH) ORDINANCE (AMENDMENT  
OF SCHEDULE 2) ORDER 2010**

(Made by the Secretary for Food and Health under section 16A of  
the Smoking (Public Health) Ordinance (Cap. 371))

**1. Commencement**

This Order comes into operation on 15 April 2010.

**2. Designated no smoking areas and exempt areas**

Part 2 of Schedule 2 to the Smoking (Public Health) Ordinance (Cap. 371) is amended by adding—

- “11. An area set aside by the Director of Immigration under rule 11A of Schedule 1 to the Immigration (Treatment of Detainees) Order (Cap. 115 sub. leg. E) in a place specified in Schedule 2 to that Order for smoking by persons detained there.”

**Explanatory Note**

Part 2 of Schedule 2 to the Smoking (Public Health) Ordinance (Cap. 371) (“Ordinance”) describes the areas that are exempted from the prohibition on smoking imposed by section 3 of the Ordinance. This Order amends that Part to exempt from the smoking prohibition an area set aside by the Director of Immigration in a place of detention specified in Schedule 2 to the Immigration (Treatment of Detainees) Order (Cap. 115 sub. leg. E).
