Subject Private cars per km per day

Dear Legislators,

In advance of this afternoon's Bills Committee on FRT, I attach a graph showing the average number of private cars per km of roads per day, on a yearly basis since 1996, using Transport Department data.

As you can see, the figure has fluctuated with the economic cycles, but there is no discernable trend. I hope that the Government will apologise for referring to my work as "shoddy", "slack" and "misleading" by using a 2000-2009 comparison. If anything is shoddy, it is the way they use selective statistics to make their case and fail to address the fact that FRT has only a distant relationship to rush-hour congestion, if at all.

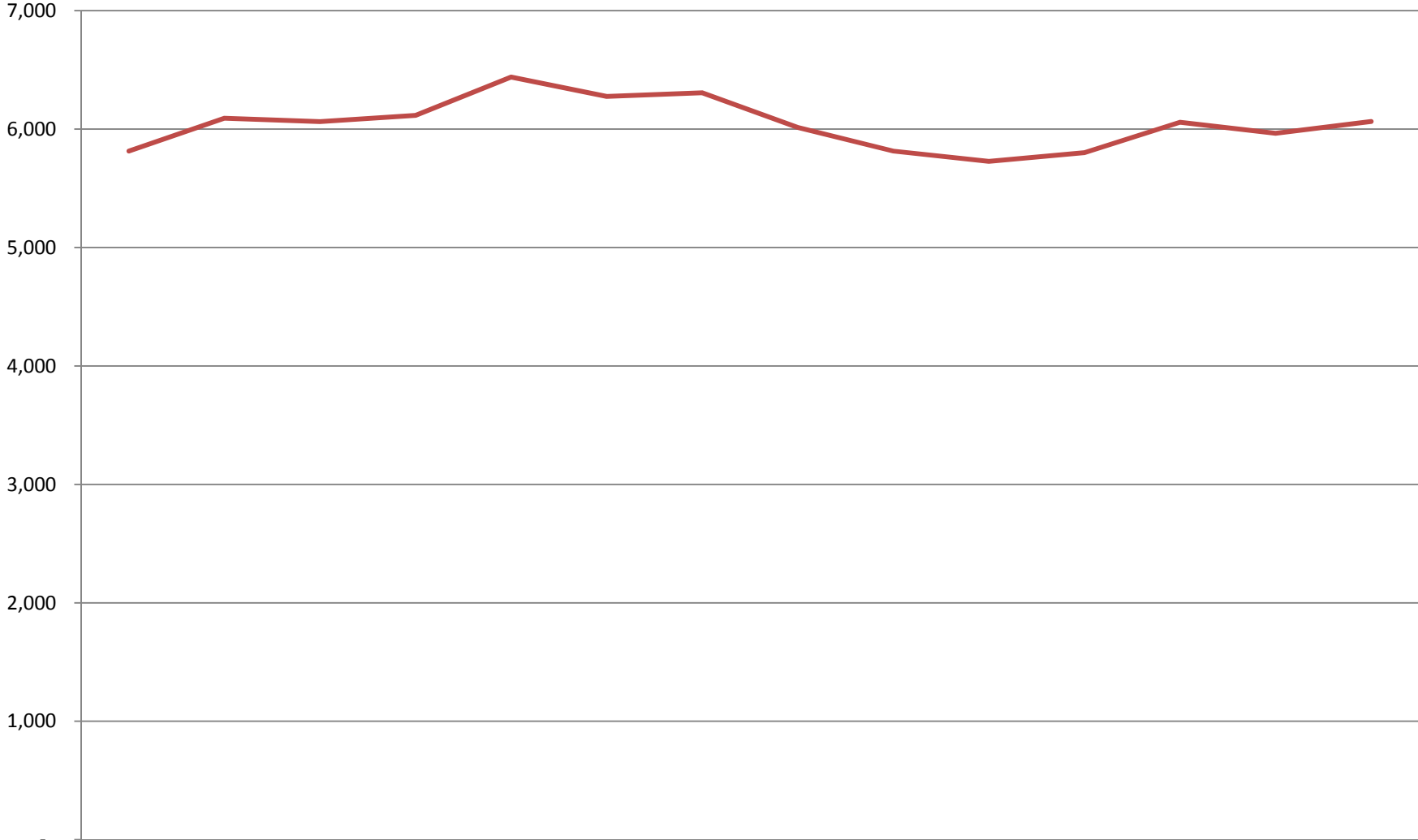
