# Paper for the Bills Committee on Securities and Futures (Amendment) Bill 2011

#### Information Note on certain expressions in Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants' proposed safe harbour

#### **Background**

At the meeting of the Bills Committee held on 31 January 2012, information was sought on whether expressions used in the safe harbour proposed by Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants (HKICPA), namely "acting in good faith", "taken reasonable steps", "have exercised judgment", "reasonable prudence" and "properly considered" are present in other ordinances. As requested by Members, the information provided at the meeting is elaborated below for Members' reference.

#### "acting in good faith"

- 2. The expression "in good faith" is found in a large number of provisions in the legislation in Hong Kong currently in force, including 20 provisions<sup>2</sup> of the Securities and Futures Ordinance (Cap. 571).
- 3. The exact expression "acting in good faith" is found in 46 provisions contained in 42 pieces of legislation, a list of which is attached at Annex A. Amongst the 46 provisions, 35 of which relate to immunity from liability<sup>3</sup>.

#### "taken reasonable steps"

4. This expression is found in 9 provisions contained in 8 pieces of legislation, a list of which is attached at <u>Annex B</u>. Amongst the 9 provisions, 3 of which relate to providing a defence to statutory offences<sup>4</sup>.
