I. Election of Chairman

<u>Dr Raymond HO</u>, the member who had the highest precedence in the Council among those who were present at the meeting, presided over the election of Chairman.

- 2. <u>Ms Cyd HO</u> was nominated by <u>Mr CHEUNG Man-kwong</u> and the nomination was seconded by <u>Dr David LI</u> and <u>Ms Audrey EU</u>. There being no other nominations, <u>Ms Cyd HO</u> was elected Chairman of the Bills Committee.
- 3. <u>The Chairman</u> invited members' views on the need for electing a Deputy Chairman. <u>Members</u> considered it not necessary.
- 4 <u>Dr David LI</u> declared interest as the Pro-Chancellor of the University of Hong Kong ("HKU"). <u>Mr James TO</u> declared interest as a member of the Court of HKU elected from among Members of the Legislative Council.

- 6. <u>Members</u> agreed that as Dr David LI was the member in charge of the Bill, he should be responsible for explaining the Bill to the Bills Committee. - 7. <u>Members</u> further agreed that the Education Bureau ("EDB") and the University Grants Committee ("UGC") should be invited to attend meetings of the Bills Committee on a need basis. <u>Members</u> considered that EDB should be invited as the Bill was concerned with the amendments to the role descriptions of the Court and the Council of HKU. Members might wish to have information on the functions and roles of the courts and councils of other UGC-funded institutions. UGC should be invited too as it should listen to the views exchanged in the scrutiny process.
