Motion debate on "The 4 June incident" to be held at the Legislative Council meeting of Wednesday, 18 May 2011

1. Hon LEE Cheuk-yan's original motion

That this Council urges that: the 4 June incident be not forgotten and the 1989 pro-democracy movement be vindicated.

2. Motion as amended by Hon Albert HO Chun-yan

That this Council urges that: the 4 June incident be not forgotten and the 1989 pro-democracy movement be vindicated, and also urges the Central Government to refrain from taking actions of unlawful and arbitrary surveillance, detention and suppression of dissidents and human rights activists, including LIU Xiaobo and AI Weiwei, etc., expeditiously ratify, through the National People's Congress, the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights signed in 1998, and effect its full implementation, so as to make good preparation for the vindication of the 1989 pro-democracy movement.
