431RO – Tuen Mun River beautification – Tin Hau Temple Plaza

Further to discussion of this item at the PWSC meeting on 20 April 2011, the Administration has been requested to address member's concerns as follows:

Issue

At the request of Hon Miriam LAU, the Administration agreed to consider providing pedestrain crossing facilities near the four pedestrian access to the Tin Hau Temple Plaza along Hung Cheung Road and Tin Hau Road, and to provide a detailed site plan showing the facilities.

Response

In response to Hon Miriam LAU's request, we have reviewed the existing provision of pedestrian crossing facilities around the Tin Hau Temple Plaza, which we found to be sufficient for normal pedestrian flow. If large-scale function is to be held at the Tin Hau Temple Plaza, we will liaise with the Transport Department and the Police in advance for special transport and pedestrian crossing arrangements. The site plan of the Tin Hau Temple Plaza showing the existing pedestrian crossing facilities is enclosed at **Annex**.
