Action

I. Confirmation of the minutes of the 10th meeting held on 7 January 2011

(LC Paper No. CB(2) 777/10-11)

The minutes were confirmed.

II. Matters arising

Report by the Chairman on the meeting with the Chief Secretary for Administration ("CS")

Country Parks (Designation) (Consolidation) (Amendment) Order 2010 ("the Order")

2. <u>The Chairman</u> said that at the last House Committee meeting, Members had discussed CS's letter dated 4 January 2011 to the President regarding the Order. Subsequently, the President had sent a reply to CS on 11 January 2011 to convey Members' concerns, and the President's reply had been copied to Members for information on the same day.

Proposed new numbering system for bills

3. The Chairman further said that she had conveyed to CS Members' views on the proposed new numbering system for bills although it would not be used for the Companies Bill. CS had indicated that the Law Draftsman would consult Members if proposals were made in this respect.

III. Business arising from previous Council meetings

Legal Service Division report on subsidiary legislation gazetted on 7 January 2011 and tabled in Council on 12 January 2011

(LC Paper No. LS 22/10-11)

- 4. <u>The Chairman</u> said that two items of subsidiary legislation, i.e. Minimum Wage (Criteria for Approved Assessors) Notice and Minimum Wage (Assessment Methods) Notice, were gazetted on 7 January 2011 and tabled in the Council on 12 January 2011.
- 5. The Chairman further said that the Minimum Wage Ordinance enacted on 17 July 2010 provided for a mechanism for determining the remuneration of persons with disabilities upon the implementation of the statutory minimum wage. The two Notices sought to provide for the criteria for approved assessors and the methods of assessment. She added that the Legal Service Division was seeking clarification from the Administration on certain matters in relation to the two Notices and would provide a further report after considering the Administration's reply.
- 6. <u>Ms Cyd HO</u> considered it necessary to form a subcommittee to study the two Notices.
- 7. <u>The Chairman</u> proposed that a subcommittee be formed to study the two Notices in detail. <u>Members</u> agreed. The following Members agreed to join: Mr LEUNG Yiu-chung, Mr TAM Yiu-chung, Mr Tommy CHEUNG, Ms Cyd HO, Mr CHEUNG Kwok-che, Mr IP Wai-ming and Mr IP Kowk-him.
- 8. As the deadline for amending these Notices was 26 January 2011, the Chairman proposed to move a motion in her capacity as Chairman of the House Committee at the Council meeting of 19 January 2011 to extend their scrutiny period to 2 March 2011. Members agreed.

- 14. In respect of the motion on "Equal Opportunities Commission's Formal Investigation Report on Accessibility in Publicly Accessible Premises", the Chairman reminded Members that the speaking time limit would be 15 minutes for each Member.
- 15. <u>The Chairman</u> also reminded Members that the deadline for giving notice of amendments, if any, to the motions was Wednesday, 19 January 2011.
