- 1. Figures provided by HSSC for the 2010-11 academic year are estimates. According to HSSC, information on bursaries/fee remission are made available for its students via various sources (i) course promotional materials mailed to secondary schools in December each year; (ii) HSSC's website; and (iii) same information for new students in August prior to the commencement of an academic year. On the other hand, information on scholarships will be made available to students in September each year.
- 2. OUHK has no bursary for full-time face-to-face students as the University considers that students aged 25 or below are eligible for student financial assistance offered by the Government. According to OUHK, information on scholarships and financial assistance are made available for its students via various sources (i) OUHK's website; (ii) a talk on 'student finance' with printed information leaflets for new students at the beginning of an academic year; and (iii) information about the Government's financial assistance schemes will be made available for both new and current students through email, notice board and OUHK's website.
