Dear Rev. Plateros,

Thank you for your letter of 20 October 2010 to the Secretary for Education. I am authorized to reply on his behalf.

Please be advised that we are aware of the conditions of your school and have taken prompt action to deal with your emergency repair requests. With regard to the water leakage problem at your school, the necessary repair works have been completed. Depending on the circumstances, improvement works may also be carried out through the annual exercise of major repairs. We shall continue to work closely with your school to improve the existing facilities through the established means wherever necessary.

Separately, your interest in reprovisioning to a new secondary school premises in Kai Tak Development is duly noted and registered. You may wish to note that the Government seeks to improve the facilities of existing schools which do not meet prevailing standards through the Reprovisioning

and Redevelopment Programme, which is subject to technical feasibility as well as availability of resources and suitable school sites/premises. We have earmarked a few sites in Kai Tak Development for school use and the related planning works would have to tie in with the overall development plan of Kai Tak Development and the progress of the infrastructural developments in the surrounding area. Generally speaking, government-built school premises are allocated on a competitive bidding basis under the mechanism of School Allocation Exercise. We will keep you informed when we are ready to launch School Allocation Exercise for the sites concerned for reprovisioning of secondary schools and you may consider submitting an application in accordance with the established procedures.
