Implementation of Leisure and Cultural Services Projects proposed by the former Municipal Councils

Information Requested at Meetings on 11 February, 10 June and 26 August 2011

Introduction

The Panel on Home Affairs has asked for supplementary information on the planning and implementation of leisure and cultural services (LCS) projects, in particular on progress with projects proposed by the former Municipal Councils (MCs). This paper outlines the current position with regard to the planning and implementation of former MC projects and other LCS projects.

Progress with former MC LCS projects

- 2. The Panel has asked for the following information with regard to projects proposed by the former MCs
 - (a) an update on the latest progress of the 139 planned LCS projects of the former MCs;
 - (b) a preliminary timetable for the implementation of the project of the Ecological Park in Tsuen Wan;
 - (c) an implementation schedule for the 49 LCS projects of the former MCs that are under review or preliminary planning, including details on the lead time for commencement of these projects, the expected commencement date, the scheduled date of completion and reasons for delay, if any; and
 - (d) information on the LCS projects delivered by Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD) and the amount of funding that had been allocated to these projects since the dissolution of MCs in 1999. The Panel also asked for a year-on-year comparison on the number of the LCS projects and the amount of funding for these projects before and

after the dissolution of MCs, as far as possible.

- 3. As at the end of March 2012, 57 of the 139 planned LCS projects of the former MCs had been completed. Progress with the remaining 82 projects was as follows
 - six projects were under construction (details at **Annex 1.1**);
 - 13 projects were at the advanced planning stage (Annex 1.2);
 - 17 had been deleted or deferred after consultation with the District Councils (DCs) concerned (Annex 1.3);
 - seven sites or projects had been partially developed (Annex 1.4);
 - seven projects were under preliminary planning (Annex 1.5);
 - 12 projects were under review (Annex 1.6); and
 - 20 projects will not be pursued for the time being either because the sites are not available or they have been accorded low priority by the respective DCs (Annex 1.7).
- 4. As regards the project "Ecological Park (Tso Kung Tam Valley, Tsuen Wan)", according to the technical feasibility study, the proposed project will involve resumption of private land and a gazetted road (Chiu Tam Path). In addition, large-scale slope stabilization works need to be carried out. LCSD is reviewing with the relevant departments the technical feasibility of the project and revising the project scope. LCSD proposes to take forward the project in phases and plans to consult the District Facilities Management Committee (DFMC) of the Tsuen Wan DC on the way forward in mid-2012.
- 5. With regard to the 49 LCS projects of the former MCs that are under review or preliminary planning, we have completed technical feasibility studies for three of these projects, namely, the New Territories East Cross-District Community Cultural Centre, the Sports Centre in Area 24D, Sha Tin and Local Open Space in Area 6, Tai Po. These three projects are included in the list of 13 projects at the advanced planning stage (see **Annex 1.2**). Details of the status of the remaining 46 projects are at **Annexes 1.4 to 1.7**.
- 6. In the five years before the dissolution of the MCs (from 1995/96 to 1999/2000), construction work started on a total of 65 LCS projects. The total approved project estimates of these projects was \$8.35 billion, representing an average of 13 projects at an average cost of \$1.67 billion annually. In the five years from 2006/07 to 2010/11, work started on 57 LCS projects with total approved project estimates of \$14.96 billion. The average number of projects that commenced construction annually during the period was 11.4 and the annual average cost was \$2.99 billion. Details are at **Annex 2**.

Planning and Provision of Sports Facilities in the 18 Districts

- 7. The Panel has also asked for information on the provision of sports facilities at the district level, in particular
 - (a) the level of provision suggested by the Hong Kong Planning Standards and Guidelines ("HKPSG") for facilities such as swimming pool complex, football pitch, jogging track and sports centres;
 - (b) the current level of provision of such facilities in each of the 18 districts (preferably in a table form);
 - (c) the implementation timetable of the sports centre project in Plover Cove Road in Area 1, Tai Po; and
 - (d) the implementation timetable and the current status of a proposal to build a swimming pool in the District Open Space in Area 107, Tin Shui Wai.
- 8. The HKPSG provide a reference for the standards of provision for key public sports facilities per head of population, for example -
 - (a) Swimming pool complex one per 287,000 people;
 - (b) Football pitch (11-a-side) one per 100,000 people:
 - (c) Jogging track 500m to 1,000m per 30,000 people; and
 - (d) Sports centre one per 50,000 to 65,000 people.
- 9. **Annex 3** sets out the standards of provision for key public sports facilities as recommended by the HKPSG and the current levels of provision of such facilities by LCSD in each of the 18 districts.
- 10. On 17 January 2012, we consulted the DFMC of Tai Po DC on the revised project scope for the sports centre project at Plover Cove Road in Area 1. The Architectural Services Department is now conducting a technical feasibility study for the project.
- 11. In Yuen Long District (including Tin Shui Wai), LCSD currently provides three public swimming-pool facilities: the Yuen Long Swimming Pool,

Tin Shui Wai Swimming Pool and an indoor heated swimming pool in the Ping Shan Tin Shui Wai Leisure and Cultural Building. The proposed swimming-pool complex project in Area 107, Tin Shui Wai would include a main pool of 50m x 25m as well as other additional swimming facilities for the district. We consulted the Yuen Long DC on the proposed facilities in March 2012 and they agreed to the project scope.

Response to DCs' views

12. The Panel has asked us to provide a written response to the 18 District Councils' ("DCs") views on the progress of outstanding LCS projects and new LCS projects supported by DCs as set out in Appendices III to VI to the background brief prepared by the Legislative Council Secretariat [LC Paper No. CB(2)2522/10-11(02)].

Our responses to the views of the 18 DCs are set out in **Annexes 4.1 to 4.4**.
