Legislative Council Panel on Home Affairs Alternative Option of Venue Planning for 2023 Asian Games Bid

Purpose

This paper briefly reports the alternative option (<u>Annex 1</u>) proposed by the Venue and Events Sub-Committee (VESC) of the 2023 Asian Games Provisional Bid Committee (AGPBC).

Background

- 2. At the VESC meeting held on 9 November 2010, members examined in detail the Government's plan for the provision of venues if Hong Kong bids to host the Asian Games (Annex 2). In response to the general public concern over the possible cost of hosting the Games, members considered that it would be viable to scale back the original plan and not to upgrade three proposed indoor sports centres in Yuen Long, Tai Po and Sha Tin (the estimated total cost for upgrading these three centres is \$8.5 billion). This alternative option could therefore reduce the direct cost of hosting the Games from the original estimate of about \$13.7 14.5 billion, to about \$6 billion.
- 3. As no secondary courts would be provided under this alternative option, the preliminary rounds of three events (basketball, handball and volleyball) would need to be distributed among different venues. Although the spectator capacity of the three indoor sports centres would be reduced, it would still be possible to provide 1000 to 1200 spectator seats in each of the venues during the Games for the preliminary heats. Temporary overlay works would also be required to provide the various related ancillary facilities such as VIP rooms, press rooms, medical services, etc.
- 4. Members proposed that in addition to the three indoor sports

centres, the preliminary heats for basketball, handball and volleyball could also take place at the Public Library and Indoor Recreation Centre in Yuen Long, at the Sports Centre in Fanling/Sheung Shui both now under construction and at the existing Ma On Shan indoor sports centre. As a result of the proposed changes in the use of venues, wrestling and weightlifting would be relocated to the new Tseung Kwan O Complex now under construction.

5. The differences between the alternative option and the original proposal are summarized in **Annex 3**.

Conclusion

6. The option put forward by the VESC gives the public an opportunity to consider from a fresh perspective whether Hong Kong should bid to host the 2023 Games in the light of the potential reduced direct capital cost, the benefits that hosting the Games could bring to Hong Kong and the opportunity for building up a strong sporting culture for our community and investing in our next generation
