- anticipate keen market competition for very experienced candidates; will offer ICE in work types with a higher proportion of civil service vacancies and NCSC staff already with salaries higher than the entry pay of the APO rank
- already communicated with staff
- details to be published in the recruitment advertisement; will operate according to mechanism
