

Supplement to my note on the Godfrey Saga (31 May 2011)

Please convey to the Panel Point 4 in addition to the three points I recommended to LegCo to proceed with:

1. Go ahead with the proposed summon of Godfrey, Tsang, Tse and others as deemed necessary. This will provide at least a platform to both parties to testify. The data thus obtained may be used for future verification. However, this is still far away from the desirable solution that is not only legally but ethically sound.
2. Re-assess all the proposals received on the basis of the tender specification. The results of re-assessment will throw light to verify the justification as to whom the contract should be awarded. This will also provide an objective cross-check of Godfrey's allegation and the Government's defence.
3. Appoint independent qualified IT professionals to conduct the re-assessment, and select only those who are potentially free of conflict-of-interest and apparently without political affiliations.
4. The re-assessment is to carry out an *ethical analysis*, in addition to the usual *feasibility and risk analyses*.
