

First LegCo exhibition cum career talk held in university successfully concluded (with photos)



The Legislative Council (LegCo) has organized for the first time a series of exhibitions and career talks in three local universities, of which the first stop of this series of exhibitions and talks held at the Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK), which lasted for five days, was successfully concluded today (February 25). The exhibition has attracted a total of around 2,000 visitors, while more than 70 students attended the career talk.
