Results of Legislative Council elections

1. Background

1.1 At its meeting on 24 May 2011, the Panel on Constitutional Affairs requested the Research Division to provide information on the results of the Legislative Council ("LegCo") geographical constituency ("GC") elections and by-elections held after the establishment of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region ("the HKSAR").

1.2 Since the establishment of the HKSAR in July 1997, four LegCo general elections were held in 1998, 2000, 2004 and 2008 respectively, and three GC by-elections were held, namely the 2000 LegCo By-election (Hong Kong Island GC)¹, the 2007 LegCo By-election (Hong Kong Island GC)² and the 2010 LegCo By-election³. In this fact sheet, the results of these LegCo GC elections⁴ and by-elections⁵ are presented in the following manner:

- (a) 2008 LegCo GC Election: Tables 1a to 1e;
- (b) 2004 LegCo GC Election: Tables 2a to 2e;
- (c) 2000 LegCo GC Election: Tables 3a to 3e;

¹ The By-election was held to fill a vacancy in the Hong Kong Island GC arising from the non-acceptance of office of a Member returned by this GC in the 2000 LegCo Election.

² The By-election was held to fill a vacancy in the Hong Kong Island GC arising from the passing away of a Member returned by this GC in the 2004 LegCo Election.

³ The By-election was held to fill five vacancies (one vacancy in each of the five GCs) arising from the resignation of five Members returned by the respective GCs in the 2008 LegCo Election.

⁴ The LegCo election in Hong Kong has adopted the list proportional representation voting system for GCs since 1998 (Constitutional and Mainland Affairs Bureau, 2011, para. 8). According to the "Guidelines on Election-related Activities in respect of the Legislative Council Election" (para. 2.23), at a GC election, an elector is entitled to cast a single vote for a list. The number of valid votes cast for the election of the GC will be divided by the number of vacancies to be elected for that GC to arrive at the quota of votes. Each list that reaches the quota will have one candidate on the list elected. When not all the vacancies are filled by applying the quota, the filling of the remaining seat or seats will be decided by the largest remainder of valid votes cast for each list after the deduction of the quota or a number of quotas of votes cast for that list.

⁵ The relevant by-elections were to fill a single vacant seat in a GC or a single vacant seat in each of the GCs (refer to Footnotes 1 to 3). In these by-elections, the first-past-the-post voting system was adopted (Constitutional and Mainland Affairs Bureau, 2011, para. 9), i.e. for each GC, the candidate who received the largest number of valid votes was elected.
