# PUBLIC HEALTH AND MUNICIPAL SERVICES DESIGNATION OF PUBLIC SWIMMING POOLS

### **INTRODUCTION**

The Director of Leisure and Cultural Services, in her capacity as the Authority ("Authority") under the Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance Cap.132 ("the Ordinance"), manages the public swimming pools listed in the Fourteenth Schedule to the Ordinance. Under Section 42A of the Ordinance, the Authority may, from time to time, by order designate public swimming pools, and may by order amend, or add to, or delete from the Fourteenth Schedule.

2. We propose to introduce the amendments through the Public Health and Municipal Services (Designation of Public Swimming Pool) Order 2011 (Order) at <u>Annex A</u> and the Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Amendment of Fourteenth Schedule) Order 2011 (Amendment Order) at <u>Annex B</u> to this Brief to designate the venue specified in the Schedule at the Order for use as a public swimming pool.

### **JUSTIFICATIONS**

3. The proposal to designate one new venue as public swimming pool will enable the Authority to enforce the regulations relating to this public swimming pool for proper management.

# **Designation of public swimming pool**

4. The Ping Shan Tin Shui Wai Swimming Pool will be designated as a public swimming pool and included in the Fourteenth Schedule.

#### AMENDMENT OF FOURTEENTH SCHEDULE

5. The Amendment Order at Annex B amends the Fourteenth Schedule to the Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Cap.

132) to update the list of public swimming pools.
