Bills

First Reading

Inland Revenue (Amendment) Bill 2012

The Bill was read the first time and ordered to be set down for Second Reading under Rule 53(3) of the Rules of Procedure.

Second Reading

Inland Revenue (Amendment) Bill 2012

The Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury moved the Second Reading and spoke on the Bill.

Question on the Second Reading proposed. The President stated that in accordance with Rule 54(4) of the Rules of Procedure, the debate was adjourned and the Bill was referred to the House Committee.

Fisheries Protection (Amendment) Bill 2011

Resumption of Second Reading debate

The debate on the Second Reading which was moved on 9 November 2011 resumed.

On behalf of Hon Tommy CHEUNG, Chairman of the Bills Committee on Fisheries Protection (Amendment) Bill 2011, who was not present at the meeting, Hon Vincent FANG addressed the Council on the Committee's Report.

Hon Albert CHAN spoke on the Bill.

While Hon Albert CHAN was speaking, the President left the chair at 1:52 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

Three Members and Hon TAM Yiu-chung spoke on the Bill.

At 2:27 pm, while Hon TAM Yiu-chung was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Two other Members spoke on the Bill.

The Secretary for Food and Health replied.

Question on the Second Reading put.

Hon WONG Yuk-man claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to proceed to a division.

The President announced that 45 Members were present and 44 were in favour of the motion (voting record in **Appendix I**). Since the question was agreed by a majority of the Members present, he declared that the motion was passed.

Bill read the second time and committed to a committee of the whole Council.

Committee stage

The Council went into committee and considered the Fisheries Protection (Amendment) Bill 2011.

Question that clauses 1, 2, 3, 5 to 9, 11 to 14, 16, 18, 19 and 20 stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

Question that clauses 4 and 10 stand part of the Bill proposed.

The Secretary for Food and Health moved amendments to clauses 4 and 10, and spoke on the amendments.

A Member spoke on the amendments.

Question on the amendments put and agreed to.

Question that clauses 4 and 10 as amended stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

Question that clause 15 stand part of the Bill proposed.

The Chairman stated that the Secretary for Food and Health had given notice to move amendments to clause 15. The Secretary's amendments to clause 15 sought to amend the proposed section 16(1) and section 42(1) in the Bill. In addition, Hon Albert CHAN had also given notice to move an amendment to clause 15. Hon Albert CHAN's amendment to clause 15 sought to add subsections 3(a), (b) and (c) to the proposed section 42 in the Bill. Irrespective of whether or not the Secretary's amendments were passed, Hon Albert CHAN might move his amendment. The Chairman then ordered a joint debate on the original provisions and the amendments.

The Secretary for Food and Health moved amendments to clause 15 and spoke on the amendments.

Hon Albert CHAN and two Members spoke on the amendments.

The Secretary for Food and Health spoke again.

Hon Albert CHAN sought elucidation of a point raised by the Secretary for Food and Health in his speech. The Secretary for Food and Health elucidated.

Question on the amendments put and agreed to.

Hon Albert CHAN moved a further amendment to clause 15 to add subsections 3(a), (b) and (c) to the proposed section 42 in the Bill.

Question on the amendment moved by Hon Albert CHAN put.

Hon Albert CHAN claimed a division. The Chairman then ordered the committee to proceed to a division.

The Chairman announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 23 were present, three were in favour of the amendment, 19 against them and one abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 22 were present, five were in favour of the amendment and 16 against them (voting record in **Appendix II**). Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, he declared that the amendment was negatived.

Question that clause 15 as amended stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

Question that clause 17 stand part of the Bill proposed.

The Chairman stated that the Secretary for Food and Health had given notice to move amendments to clause 17. The Secretary's amendments to clause 17 sought to add section 1A to the proposed Schedule 2 and to amend the proposed section 3 in the Bill. In addition, Hon Albert CHAN had also given notice to move amendments to clause 17. Hon Albert CHAN's amendments to clause 17 sought to add sections 4 and 5 to the proposed Schedule 2 in the Bill. Irrespective of whether or not the Secretary's amendments were passed, Hon Albert CHAN might move his amendments. The Chairman then ordered a joint debate on the original provisions and the amendments.

The Secretary for Food and Health moved amendments to clause 17 and spoke on the amendments.

Hon Albert CHAN and two Members spoke on the amendments.

The Secretary for Food and Health spoke again.

Question on the amendments put and agreed to.

Hon Albert CHAN moved a further amendment to clause 17 to add sections 4 and 5 to the proposed Schedule 2 in the Bill.

Question that the amendment moved by Hon Albert CHAN put.

Hon Albert CHAN claimed a division. The Chairman then ordered the committee to proceed to a division.

The Chairman announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 22 were present, 19 were against the amendment and three abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 25 were present, three were in favour of the amendment and 21 against it (voting record in **Appendix III**). Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, he declared that the amendment was negatived.

Question that clause 17 as amended stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

The Council then resumed.

Third Reading

The Secretary for Food and Health reported that

the Fisheries Protection (Amendment) Bill 2011

had passed through the Committee stage with amendments. The Bill was ordered to be set down for Third Reading under Rule 59 of the Rules of Procedure.

The Secretary for Food and Health moved that the Bill be read the third time and do pass.

Question on the Third Reading proposed.

A Member spoke on the motion.

Question on the Third Reading put.

Hon Albert CHAN claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to proceed to a division.

The President announced that 46 Members were present, 41 were in favour of the motion, three against it and one abstained (voting record in **Appendix IV**). Since the question was agreed by a majority of the Members present, he declared that the motion was passed.

Bill read the third time and passed.

Motion for the adjournment of the Council

The President stated that Hon LEUNG Kwok-hung had sought his approval to move the following motion under Rule 16(2) of the Rules of Procedure:

That this Council shall now adjourn to debate on the case of Mr CHEN Guangcheng and his nephew CHEN Kegui.

As Hon LEUNG Kwok-hung had set out the grounds for his request in writing, the President stated that he did not have to present his arguments in detail during the Council meeting.

The President stated that after careful consideration of the grounds of Hon LEUNG Kwok-hung's request for moving the motion, he had decided not to grant his approval and would write to Mr LEUNG and Members detailing the reasons for his decision.

Electoral Legislation (Miscellaneous Amendments) Bill 2012

Resumption of Second Reading debate

The debate on the Second Reading which was moved on 8 February 2012 resumed.

Hon IP Kwok-him, Chairman of the Bills Committee on Electoral Legislation (Miscellaneous Amendments) Bill 2012, addressed the Council on the Committee's Report. After the address, he spoke on the Bill in his personal capacity as a Member.

Six Members spoke on the Bill.

The Secretary for Constitutional and Mainland Affairs replied.

Question on the Second Reading put and agreed to.

Bill read the second time and committed to a committee of the whole Council.

Committee stage

The Council went into committee and considered the Electoral Legislation (Miscellaneous Amendments) Bill 2012.

Question that clauses 2, 4 to 30, 32, 33, 34, 36, 37, 39 to 44 and 46 to 67 stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

Question that clauses 1, 3, 31, 35, 38 and 45 stand part of the Bill proposed.

The Secretary for Constitutional and Mainland Affairs moved amendments to the aforesaid clauses and spoke on the amendments.

Question on the amendments put and agreed to.

Question that clauses 1, 3, 31, 35, 38 and 45 as amended stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

The new clauses 33A and 35A, the new Division heading before new clause 38A, the new clauses 38A, 38B, 45A and 51A, the new Division heading before new clause 52A, the new clauses 52A and 52B, the new Division heading before new clause 52C, the new clause 52C, the new Division heading before new clause 52D, and the new clauses 52D, 52E and 52F read the first time.

The Secretary for Constitutional and Mainland Affairs moved the Second Reading of the aforesaid new clauses and Division headings, and spoke on the new clauses and Division headings.

Question on the Second Reading of the aforesaid new clauses and Division headings proposed.

Four Members spoke on the new clauses and Division headings.

The Secretary for Constitutional and Mainland Affairs spoke again.

Question on the Second Reading of the aforesaid new clauses and Division headings put.

Hon WONG Yuk-man claimed a division. The Chairman then ordered the committee to proceed to a division.

The Chairman announced that 50 Members were present, 46 were in favour of the motion, two against it and one abstained (voting record in **Appendix V**). Since the question was agreed by a majority of the Members present, he declared that the motion was passed.

The new clauses 33A and 35A, the new Division heading before new clause 38A, the new clauses 38A, 38B, 45A and 51A, the new Division heading before new clause 52A, the new clauses 52A and 52B, the new Division heading before new clause 52C, the new clause 52C, the new Division heading before new clause 52D, and the new clauses 52D, 52E and 52F read the second time.

The Secretary for Constitutional and Mainland Affairs moved the addition of the aforesaid new clauses and Division headings to the Bill.

Question on the addition proposed, put and agreed to.

The Council then resumed.

Third Reading

The Secretary for Constitutional and Mainland Affairs reported that

the Electoral Legislation (Miscellaneous Amendments) Bill 2012

had passed through the Committee stage with amendments. The Bill was ordered to be set down for Third Reading under Rule 59 of the Rules of Procedure.

The Secretary for Constitutional and Mainland Affairs moved that the Bill be read the third time and do pass.

Question on the Third Reading proposed, put and agreed to.

Bill read the third time and passed.

Legislative Council (Amendment) Bill 2012

Committee stage

The Council went into committee and continued to examine the clauses of the Legislative Council (Amendment) Bill 2012 and the amendments thereto.

The Chairman stated that Hon WONG Yuk-man had given notice to move 74 amendments to clauses 1, 2 and 3. The Secretary for Constitutional and Mainland Affairs had also given notice to move one amendment to clause 3. In addition, Hon Albert CHAN had also given notice to move 1 232 amendments to clause 3. There were a total of 1 307 amendments to the Bill.

Hon Audrey EU raised a point of order. She moved that further proceedings of the committee be adjourned under Rule 40(4) of the Rules of Procedure.

Question that Hon Audrey EU's motion proposed.

The Chairman suspended the meeting at 7:32 pm.

The committee resumed at 8:29 pm.

Motion under Rule 40(4) of the Rules of Procedure that further proceedings of the Committee of the whole Council be now adjourned

Hon Audrey EU spoke on the motion.

With regard to Hon Audrey EU's remarks that this motion for adjournment could be moved only once and, if negatived, could not be moved for a second time, the Chairman clarified that this motion for adjournment was moved under Rule 40(4) which governed the proceedings at the Committee stage, and if this motion was negatived, the committee should continue with its proceedings, but there was no stipulation as to whether such a motion could be moved again.

The Chairman stated that if another Member moved the same motion for adjournment again immediately after the debate on Hon Audrey EU's motion had ended, he would consider whether the timing of doing so was reasonable and whether permission should be given.

The Secretary for Constitutional and Mainland Affairs spoke on the motion.

Five Members spoke on the motion.

The Chairman suspended the meeting at 9:56 pm.

The committee resumed at 9:00 am on 10 May 2012.

Two Members and Hon Paul TSE spoke on the motion.

While Hon Paul TSE was speaking, the Chairman, in response to the remarks made in Mr TSE's speech, stated that he would not enter into a debate on his ruling with Members at the meeting and would be glad to discuss with Members outside the meeting.

Hon CHIM Pui-chung and Dr Hon Margaret NG spoke on Hon Paul TSE's remarks.

Hon Paul TSE continued to speak on the motion.

Eleven more Members spoke on the motion.

The Secretary for Constitutional and Mainland Affairs spoke again.

Hon Audrey EU replied.

Question on the motion put.

Hon Audrey EU claimed a division. The Chairman then ordered the committee to proceed to a division.

The Chairman announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 25 were present, six were in favour of the motion and 19 against it; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 26 were present, 16 were in favour of the motion and nine against it (voting record in **Appendix VI**). Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, he declared that the motion was negatived.

Legislative Council (Amendment) Bill 2012

Committee stage

The Chairman ordered that the committee would proceed to the joint debate on the original provisions, together with 74 amendments proposed by Hon WONG Yuk-man, one amendment proposed by the Secretary for Constitutional and Mainland Affairs and 1 232 amendments proposed by Hon Albert CHAN. The committee would first put to vote 54 amendments to clause 1 in order, and then put to vote six amendments to clause 2 in order, and finally put to vote 1 247 amendments to clause 3 in order.

Hon WONG Yuk-man spoke on the amendments.

While Hon WONG Yuk-man was speaking, Hon IP Kwok-him raised a point of order seeking the Chairman's ruling on the scope of the debate, as he could only hear Hon WONG Yuk-man repeatedly mentioning filibustering in his speech but not the reasons for proposing the amendments.

The Chairman stated that he would stop a Member from speaking if he considered that the Member had deviated from the question in his speech. The Chairman reminded Hon WONG Yuk-man that under Rule 45(1) of the Rules of Procedure, the Chairman was obliged to direct a Member to discontinue his speech if he persisted in irrelevance of his own or other Members' argument in the debate.

Hon WONG Yuk-man continued to speak.

The Chairman suspended the meeting at 12:30 pm.

The committee resumed at 1:30 pm.

The Secretary for Constitutional and Mainland Affairs spoke on the amendments.

Hon Albert CHAN spoke on the amendments.

While Hon Albert CHAN was speaking, Hon Starry LEE raised a point of order, asking whether Hon Albert CHAN's speech concerning the speaking arrangements of Members of Parliaments in other places had deviated from the question under debate.

The Chairman reminded Hon Albert CHAN that in accordance with Rule 56(1) of the Rules of Procedure, the committee, when examining a Bill, "shall not discuss the principles of the bill but only its details", and he should focus on the details of the provisions of the Bill.

Hon Albert CHAN continued to speak. While he was speaking, Hon WONG Kwok-hing crossed the floor of the Chamber. The Chairman reminded him not to do so during the meeting.

Hon Albert CHAN raised a point of order on whether Hon Starry LEE was in compliance with the Rules of Procedure when she displayed objects on the desk of another Member without the latter's consent.

The Chairman ruled that there was no rule in the Rules of Procedure prohibiting the display of objects on a Member's seat when the Member was not in his seat.

Seven Members spoke on the amendments.

The Chairman suspended the meeting at 4:07 pm.

Eight Members spoke on the amendments.

The Chairman suspended the meeting at 7:15 pm.

The committee resumed at 8:31 pm.

A Member and Hon Paul TSE spoke on the amendments.

While Hon Paul TSE was speaking, Hon Albert CHAN asked the Chairman whether Hon Paul TSE had used offensive language in his speech about Hon WONG Yuk-man.

The Chairman ruled that Hon Paul TSE's speech was not offensive to any Member.

Hon Paul TSE continued to speak.

Hon CHIM Pui-chung spoke on the amendments.

While Hon CHIM Pui-chung was speaking, the Chairman reminded him that he should focus on the details of the provisions during the Committee stage.

Six more Members spoke on the amendments.

Hon Albert CHAN and two other Members spoke on the amendments. While they were speaking, the Chairman repeatedly reminded them that their speeches should be relevant to the amendments and should not be repetitive. By the time the meeting was suspended, the Chairman had directed the Clerk to summon Members to the meeting for 15 times as Members drew his attention to the absence of a quorum. Each time a quorum was then present.

The Chairman suspended the meeting at 9:56 pm.

* * * * * *

The committee resumed at 9:00 am on 11 May 2012.

The Chairman stated that the committee had already spent more than seven hours on the joint debate and a number of Members had spoken repeatedly. He reminded Members that if any Member kept making remarks irrelevant to the provisions and the amendments in question or tedious repetition of his own or other Members' arguments in the debate, he would direct him to discontinue his speech.

Eight Members spoke on the amendments.

Someone in the public gallery yelled noisily and threw a shoe into the Chamber. The Chairman ordered that person to leave the public gallery and suspended the meeting at 11:17 am.

* * * * * *

The committee resumed at 11:25 am.

Hon Albert CHAN continued to speak. While he was speaking, the Chairman reminded that he should not repeat the contents of his speech by using another language.

Hon Albert CHAN continued to speak.

While Hon Albert CHAN was speaking, Hon LEUNG Kwok-hung drew the attention of the Chairman to the absence of a quorum. The Chairman directed the Clerk to summon Members to the meeting. A quorum was then present.

While the quorum bell was ringing, Hon Paul TSE raised a point of order regarding the rules of speaking and the execution of such rules by the Chairman.

The Chairman stated that the requirements on the contents of Members' speeches and their manner of speaking under the Rules of Procedure were mainly twofold: firstly, Members should not digress from the subject; and secondly, Members should not repeat the contents of their speeches. He said that in most circumstances, a judgment as to whether the remarks made by a Member had deviated from the subject could only be given after the Member had spoken for some time, or even after he had finished speaking. Further, regarding repetition, he said that it might be unreasonable to completely disallow a Member to repeat his arguments in the course of a debate, but he stated a general rule that if a Member spoke more than once in the same session and took up considerable speaking time as the number of times he spoke increased, the Chairman would have stronger reasons to stringently enforce the requirements on digression and repetition to avoid wasting the time of the Council.

The Chairman also stated that it would be difficult to rigidly determine how many warnings should be given before he could rule that the conduct of the Member concerned was grossly disorderly if he had repeatedly violated the Rules of Procedures, but he reminded Members who had spoken more than once that if they insisted on not heeding the Chairman's advice and kept repeating themselves, or persisted in irrelevance or tedious repetition of arguments in violation of Rule 45 of the Rules of Procedure, he would not allow them to speak anymore.

Hon Albert CHAN continued to speak.

Four Members spoke on the amendments.

By the time the meeting was suspended for a break, the Chairman had directed the Clerk to summon Members to the meeting for seven times as Members drew his attention to the absence of a quorum. Each time a quorum was then present.

The Chairman suspended the meeting at 1:00 pm.

* * * * * *

The committee resumed at 8:20 pm.

Hon Albert CHAN drew the attention of the Chairman to the absence of a quorum. The Chairman directed the Clerk to summon Members to the meeting.

Next meeting

The Council resumed. As a quorum was not present 15 minutes after Members had been summoned, the President adjourned the Council in accordance with Rule 17(3) of the Rules of Procedure. The President stated that the unfinished business of this meeting would be dealt with at the next meeting.

The Council was adjourned at 8:37 pm.
