INTERIM ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE RINGING OF THE DIVISION BELL AT MEETINGS OF THE FINANCE COMMITTEE, ESTABLISHMENT SUBCOMMITTEE AND PUBLIC WORKS SUBCOMMITTEE

The Chairman advised that members were invited to consider the proposed interim arrangements regarding the duration of the ringing of the division bell at meetings of the Finance Committee (FC) and its two subcommittees, namely, the Establishment Subcommittee (ESC) and the Public Works Subcommittee (PWSC).

2. At the invitation of the Chairman, the Clerk to FC briefed members on the proposed interim arrangements as set out in paragraphs 8 and 9 of the discussion paper. She explained that the relevant provisions in the FC Procedure, ESC Procedure and PWSC Procedure currently stipulated that where a division was ordered at a meeting of FC, ESC or PWSC, the division bell would be rung for two minutes. With the relocation of the Legislative Council to the new Legislative Council Complex (the Complex) which was four times the size of the old Legislative Council Building, it was necessary to extend the duration of the ringing of the division bell to five minutes, so that members who were not in the meeting venue but were within the Complex would have sufficient time to return to the meeting venue to vote. In the event that the division bell did not function or might not be rung, the Chairman of FC, ESC or PWSC would order the clerk to arrange for members of the respective committee or subcommittee within the precincts of the Complex to be notified

of the division, and the division would be held 10 minutes after the order had been made. She added that the same arrangements were adopted for meetings of the Legislative Council, the House Committee and the other committees and subcommittees.

- 3. The Clerk further advised that, to implement the interim arrangements, relevant provisions in the FC Procedure, ESC Procedure and PWSC Procedure in respect of the ringing of division bells would have to be suspended with immediate effect, until FC decided to remove the suspension of the relevant provisions or to amend the relevant provisions in the Procedure of FC, ESC and PWSC. Meanwhile, the Committee on Rules of Procedure would examine whether and how the relevant rules in the Legislative Council Rules of Procedure should be amended to incorporate the above arrangements.
- 4. <u>The Chairman</u> put the item to vote. The Committee approved the proposed interim arrangements.
- 5. The meeting was adjourned at 2:49 pm.
