### **Report No. 2/11-12 of the House Committee on Consideration of Subsidiary Legislation and Other Instruments**

#### **Purpose**

This report gives the outcome of the consideration of the House Committee on subsidiary legislation the period for amendment of which will expire on 9 November 2011.

#### **Subsidiary legislation considered**

2. The House Committee has considered the following items of subsidiary legislation -

3. The House Committee formed a subcommittee to study items (1) and (2) in detail at its meeting on 8 July 2011, and another subcommittee to study item (3) in detail at its meeting on 7 October 2011. The two Subcommittees had made verbal reports on their deliberations to the House Committee on 21 October 2011, and had provided written reports vide LC Paper Nos. CB(2)180/11-12 and CB(1)239/11-12 issued to Members on 28 October and 2 November 2011 respectively.

4. The House Committee considered it not necessary to form any subcommittee to study items (4) and (5).
