An Ordinance to amend The Hong Kong Polytechnic University Ordinance.

Enacted by the Legislative Council.

#### 1. Short title

This Ordinance may be cited as The Hong Kong Polytechnic University (Amendment) Ordinance 2012.

# 2. The Hong Kong Polytechnic University Ordinance amended

The Hong Kong Polytechnic University Ordinance (Cap. 1075) is amended as set out in sections 3 to 12.

- (2) A member of the Council appointed under section 10(1)(d) of the principal Ordinance who was serving immediately before the commencement of this Ordinance continues to be a member from the commencement of this Ordinance for the remaining portion of the member's term of appointment and is deemed to have been appointed under section 10(1)(d)(i) of The Hong Kong Polytechnic University Ordinance (Cap. 1075).
- (3) A member of the Council appointed under section 10(1)(f) of the principal Ordinance who was serving immediately before the commencement of this Ordinance continues to be a member from the commencement of this Ordinance for the remaining portion of the member's term of appointment and is deemed to have been appointed under section 10(1)(f)(i) of The Hong Kong Polytechnic University Ordinance (Cap. 1075).
