Action

I. Election of Chairman and Deputy Chairman

Election of Chairman

<u>Dr Margaret NG</u>, the incumbent Chairman, called for nominations for the chairmanship of the Panel. Dr Margaret NG was nominated by Dr Priscilla LEUNG and the nomination was seconded by Mr LAU Kong-wah. <u>Dr Margaret NG</u> accepted the nomination.

2. <u>Dr Priscilla LEUNG</u>, the incumbent Deputy Chairman, presided over the election of Chairman. As there was no other nomination, <u>Dr LEUNG</u> declared Dr Margaret NG elected as the Chairman of the Panel for the 2011-2012 session.

Election of Deputy Chairman

- 3. <u>The Chairman</u> called for nominations for the deputy chairmanship of the Panel. Dr Priscilla LEUNG was nominated by Mr TAM Yiu-chung and the nomination was seconded by Ms Audrey EU. <u>Dr Priscilla LEUNG</u> accepted the nomination.
- 4. As there was no other nomination, the Chairman declared Dr Priscilla LEUNG elected as the Deputy Chairman of the Panel for the 2011-2012 session.

II. Schedule of meetings for the 2011-2012 session

- 5. <u>Members</u> agreed that the regular meetings of the Panel would be held on the fourth Monday of each month at 4:30 pm, except the meetings in December 2011 and January 2012 which were re-scheduled as follows -
 - (a) as 26 December 2011 was Christmas holiday, the meeting was re-scheduled for Tuesday, 20 December 2011, at 2:30 pm; and
 - (b) as 23 January 2012 was Lunar New Year holiday, the meeting was re-scheduled for Monday, 30 January 2012, at 4:30 pm.

6. <u>Members</u> also agreed that the next regular Panel meeting would be held on 28 November 2011.

Discussion items for the special meeting

7. The Chairman said that a special meeting of the Panel would be held on Thursday, 20 October 2011 and the Panel was scheduled to receive a briefing from the Administration on the Chief Executive's 2011-2012 Policy Address. She further said that the Chief Executive-in-Council had decided to accept the recommendation of the Standing Committee on Judicial Salaries and Conditions of Service to increase the pay for Judges and Judicial Officers for 2011-2012 by 4.22% with retrospective effect from 1 April 2011. It was the Administration's initial plan to seek the approval of the Finance Committee on the proposed pay adjustment on 18 November 2011. The Administration had offered to brief the Panel before its submission of the financial proposal. Members agreed that the Panel would discuss the financial proposal before its submission to the Finance Committee and the item "2011-2012 Judicial Service Pay Adjustment" would be added to the agenda of the special meeting. Members also agreed that the special meeting would be extended for 15 minutes, i.e. from 5:30 pm to 6:45 pm, to allow sufficient time for the discussion of this item. Members further agreed that the Hong Kong Bar Association and the Law Society of Hong Kong should be invited to give views, if any, on the item.

Discussion items for the next regular meeting

- 8. <u>Members</u> agreed to discuss the following items at the next regular meeting to be held on 28 November 2011 -
 - (a) Free legal advice service a two-year pilot scheme to provide legal advice for litigants in person;
 - (b) Propose creation of a supernumerary post of Deputy Principal Government Counsel in the Legal Policy Division of Department of Justice ("DoJ"); and
 - (c) Supplementary Provision to Head 92 DoJ Subhead 234 Court costs.

IV. Any other business

Joint Subcommittee on Amendments to Land Titles Ordinance

- 9. The Chairman said that the Joint Subcommittee on Amendments to Land Titles Ordinance set up under the Panel on Development and this Panel had decided to wind up its work for the time being until the Administration had come to a policy decision. A full report on the Subcommittee's deliberations was being prepared for submission to the two Panels shortly.
- 10. There being no other business, the meeting ended at 12:00 noon.
