

To: Legislative Council Panel on Constitutional Affairs of the HKSAR

I support the Government Secretariat reorganisation proposal proposed by the Government Elect. With the addition of the two Deputy Secretaries to share the workload of the Chief Secretary for Administration and that of the Financial Secretary, the efficiency of the Office of Chief Secretary for Administration and that of the Office of the Financial Secretary will be enhanced, enabling these departments to better serve the public. The addition of a Cultural Bureau and the restructuring of Commerce Industry Bureau as well as that of the Technology and Communication Bureau is closely related to the development of the younger generation in Hong Kong. The employment rate of the Hong Kong university students is relatively low; there is the need for the Government to implement policies to create better education, employment and entrepreneurship environment for the younger generation. The three Bureaus mentioned above will enable the Government to carry out focused study, formulation and implementation of such policies. In addition, the current structure of the Hong Kong economy lacks a tangible industry, resulting in a weak spot in the long term development of Hong Kong. Therefore, I hope that the Commerce and Industry Bureau will further study into a proposal on industry structure reorganisation, formulate and implement relevant to improve the industrial structure of Hong Kong; the development of a tangible industry will help solve the current issue with the employment. The workload of the existing Development Bureau and the Transport and Housing Bureau has always been relatively heavy and the restructuring proposal proposed by the Government Elect will mitigate those burdens on the two Bureaus whilst improving the Government's ability in carrying out research on housing and land and formulating and implementing relevant policies to an area where Hong Kong public pays most attention to.

Due to the reasons discussed above, I hope that the Government Secretariat reorganisation proposal proposed by the Government Elect will be passed by the Hong Kong Legislative Council and wish that the new Government will have the best inauguration on 1st July 2012.
