#### **3.** Governance of the Hong Kong Export Credit Insurance Corporation

The Public Accounts Committee (PAC) Report No. 56 was 20 December 2011 tabled in the Council on 6 July 2011. One of the chapters in the Report is on the Hong Kong Export Credit Insurance Corporation (ECIC). As the ECIC was established in 1966, PAC is concerned that the governance structure of ECIC as prescribed by the ECIC Ordinance may not be in line with modern-day practices and requirements. Noting that the Commerce and Economic Development Bureau does not micro-manage the daily operations of the ECIC, PAC considers it all the more important for the Advisory Board to play the role of a governing board to monitor the work and performance of the ECIC as well as to oversee its In this connection, the Secretary for Commerce governance. and Economic Development undertook to conduct a review of the governance of the ECIC. The Administration will report the outcome of the review to the Panel.

#### 4. Rent allowance for officers posted to offices in the Mainland and Taiwan

The Administration will brief the Panel on the outcome of the 20 December 2011 review of the rent allowance (RA) mechanism conducted by the Constitutional and Mainland Affairs Bureau, and seek members' support for a proposal to rationalize the current system for RA payable to officers posted to offices in the Mainland and Taiwan.

#### 5. Promotion of inward investment

The Administration will update the Panel on the work of Invest Hong Kong in promoting inward investment in 2011 and outline the way forward for 2012.
