Short-term Food Assistance Service

At the meeting on 14 November 2011, Members discussed the "Additional Funding for Short-term Food Assistance Service" [see LC Paper No. CB(2)248/11-12(03)] and requested the Administration to provide information on the service statistics and the background of service users. The information is set out below.

Number of Comprehensive Social Security Assistance (CSSA) (a) recipients who received short-term food assistance service (the service)

By the end of October 2011, a total of 9 465 CSSA recipients had received the service. However, the Social Welfare Department (SWD) does not have statistics on how many of them had received the service more than once.

(b) Number of non-CSSA recipients who were referred to the Integrated Family Service Centres (IFSCs) for long-term welfare assistance

SWD does not have statistics on the number of service users (regardless of whether they are on CSSA or not) who were referred to IFSCs for long-term welfare assistance. Service users may also be referred to other service units as appropriate.

(c) Districts which had relatively more service users

By the end of October 2011, Sham Shui Po and Tuen Mun were the districts with more service users. They accounted for about 14.7% and 9.5% respectively of the total number of people served.
