Orientation Seminar for Members-elect of the Fifth Legislative Council Concluded Successfully (with photos)

The five-day orientation seminar organized by the Council ("LegCo") Legislative Secretariat Members-elect of the Fifth LegCo concluded successfully today (September 27).
