



The Competition invites conceptual proposals for the development of a prominent waterfront area at the West Kowloon Reclamation (WKR) in Hong Kong into an integrated arts, cultural and entertainment district.

The Organizer

The Competition is organized by the Planning and Lands Bureau of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (the HKSARG).

The Scheme Area

The Scheme Area is a newly reclaimed prime site of 40 hectares at the southern tip of WKR in Kowloon Peninsula, Hong Kong. It is in close proximity to Tsim Sha Tsui which is a vibrant tourist, shopping and entertainment district with a wide range of leisure, entertainment as well as arts and cultural facilities.


The Proposals

The concept plan proposals should provide vision and innovative and viable ideas that will shape the future development of this waterfront area as a unique attraction for both local people and visitors. The proposals should be aesthetically attractive, funtional, broadly

> feasible and in compliance with the policy objectives of the HKSARG in promoting arts and culture.

Development Right

There is no linkage between the Competition and the eventual development right of the Scheme Area.











It is the intention of the HKSARG that following the Competition, a team will be appointed through the normal consultants selection process, to finalize a detailed masterplan for the Scheme Area on the basis of the winning conceptual proposals, if appropriate.

Winners of the Competition will be automatically pre-qualified for inclusion in the list of consultants to be invited for bidding for the masterplanning work.

Based on the detailed masterplan, the HKSARG will then decide on how the Scheme Area will be developed. Packages within the Scheme Area suitable for private sector development will be decided by public tender, which will be open to all. Subsequent architectural design competitions may be conducted for selected individual buildings/facilities.

Winners of the Competition will also be invited to take part in bids for development and informed of the subsequent architectural design competitions for individual buildings/facilities in the Scheme Area.





Deliverables

Participants should submit a Concept Plan Proposal comprising a Development Statement, an Urban Design Concept Plan, a Master Layout Plan, perspective drawings, cross-sections and/or elevations, as well as a colour printout/photograph of a model of the proposal.

Eligibility

The Competition is open to all qualified planners and architects.

West Kowloon Reclamation will take on a new look **********************

The Government is launching a Concept Plan Competition for the development of an integrated arts, cultural and entertainment district at the West Kowloon Reclamation, which will shape the future design and development of this waterfront area as a unique attraction for both local people and visitors.

The objective of the development is to enhance Hong Kong's position as one of Asia's leading centres for the arts and for cultural and entertainment activities as well as to help create a new look for Victoria Harbour.

Announcing the launching of the Competition today (April 6), the Secretary for Planning and Lands, Mr Gordon Siu said that the Scheme Area, a piece of newly reclaimed land of 40 hectares at the southern tip of the West Kowloon Reclamation, has the full potential for attractive waterfront development.

"It is situated at a prominent waterfront location and serves as a gateway to the central Victoria Harbour. It is in close proximity to the Tsim Sha Tsui district which is a vibrant tourist, shopping and entertainment district with a wide range of leisure and cultural facilities," Mr Siu said.

The competition will provide participants with full flexibility in proposing the appropriate facilities for the Scheme Area, provided these are in line with the overall planning intention of developing it into an integrated arts, cultural and entertainment district.

They should include a number of arts and cultural facilities, entertainment as well as other facilities, with justifications on how such facilities could complement each other and the existing provision to achieve integration.

A 10-member Jury comprising experts from within and outside Hong Kong will adjudicate the submitted proposals. The Chairman is Lord Rothschild, a Jury Member of the Pritzker Architecture Prize.

"It will be assisted by a Technical Panel, comprising local experts, and an experienced Professional Advisor.

"We are honoured to have Mr I M Pei as the Honorary Special Advisor to provide advice on broad strategic issues on the Competition," Mr Siu said.

A total of five winners will be chosen and awarded cash prizes - HK\$3 million for 1st Prize, HK\$1.5 million for 2nd Prize and HK\$0.8 million for each of the three Honourable Mentions.

On the eventual development right of the Scheme Area, Mr Siu said that there will be no linkage between the competition and development rights. Following the Competition, the Government plans to appoint a team to finalise a masterplan for the Scheme Area on the basis of the winning proposals. The Government will then decide on how the Scheme Area will be developed.

Separate architectural design competitions may be organized for individual landmark buildings or facilities in the area.

Registration for the Competition will start from tomorrow (April 7) and the deadline for submission is September 29, 2001.

Details of the contest are set out in the Competition Document provided upon registration and at the Bureau's competition website http://www.plb.gov.hk/competition, which is also linked to the websites of the Home Affairs Bureau, the Planning Department, the Leisure and Cultural Services Department and the Architectural Services Department.

The result of the Competition would be announced in the first quarter of 2002.

是項發展計劃的目的是提升香港作爲亞洲一個主要文娛藝術中心的地位, 和替維多利亞港勾劃新風貌。

規劃地政局局長蕭炯柱今日(四月六日)在宣佈該項比賽時說,該規劃區 座落本港西九龍填海區南端,是一幅面積約四十公頃填海得來的新土地,具有 充份潛質成爲富吸引力的海傍發展區。

蕭炯柱說:「該區位處顯著的海傍位置,又是中央維多利亞港的門廊。該區 此鄰的尖沙咀區是一個文娛藝術設施匯聚而且充滿動感的商業旅遊區。」

比賽爲參賽者提供充份彈性,只要符合發展該區爲綜合文娛藝術區的規劃 意向,參賽者可爲規劃區建議任何合適的設施。

參賽建議須包括文娛藝術設施及其他設施,並解釋這些設施如何能互相配 合及與現有設施相輔相成。

負責評審參賽建議書的評審團由十位來自本港和海外的專家組成,主席爲 Lord Rothschild,他是普里茨克建築獎(Pritzker Architecture Prize)的評審團成員。

蕭炯柱表示:「評審團會由一個成員包括本地專家的技術評估委員會及一位富經驗的專業顧問協助。」

他說:「我們非常榮幸邀請了貝聿銘先生出任榮譽顧問,他會就比賽的策略性事宜向我們提供意見。」

比賽將選出五名得獎者,分別頒予現金獎:冠軍獎金為港幣三百萬元,亞 軍獎金為港幣一百五十萬元,另外三位獲優異獎的人士各得獎金港幣八十萬 元。

蕭炯柱表示,規劃區的最終發展權與比賽並無關連。他解釋,政府在比賽之後,計劃委任一個小組以得獎的概念規劃爲基礎,替規劃區定下規劃總綱,繼而再決定怎樣發展該區。

當局亦可能就該區個別的標誌樓宇或設施,分別舉辦建築設計比賽。

比賽登記報名工作將於明日(四月七日)開始,而參賽作品的遞交限期爲 今年九月二十九日。
