# Public Health and Municipal Services (Fees and Charges) (Leisure Facilities) Regulation

(Made by the Secretary for Home Affairs under section 124J of the Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Cap. 132))

#### 1. Commencement

This Regulation comes into operation on 5 July 2012.

### 2. Interpretation

In this Regulation—

accompanying carer (同行照料者), in relation to a disabled person, means a person who accompanies the disabled person in the capacity of a carer for the purpose of providing care to the disabled person in a public swimming pool.

#### 3. Fees

The fees specified in column 3 of the Schedule are payable in respect of the matters described in column 2 of the Schedule.

- 1. Public Swimming Pools
  - (a) A ticket for 1 month for an unlimited number of entries to all public swimming pools (except Wan Chai Swimming Pool) for—
    - (i) a person aged 3 or above, but below 14;
    - (ii) a person aged 60 or above;
    - (iii) a disabled person;
    - (iv) an accompanying carer of a disabled person; or
    - (v) a full-time student.
  - (b) A ticket for 1 month for an unlimited number of entries to all public swimming pools (except Wan Chai Swimming Pool) for a person other than those mentioned in paragraph (a).
