Action

I. Election of Chairman and Deputy Chairman

Election of Chairman

Mr LEE Cheuk-yan, the member who had the highest precedence among members of the Bills Committee present at the meeting, presided at the election of the chairmanship of the Bills Committee. Mr LEE invited nominations for the chairmanship of the Bills Committee.

- 2. Ms Starry LEE was nominated by Mr WONG Ting-kwong and the nomination was seconded by Mr CHAN Kam-lam. Ms Starry LEE accepted the nomination.
- 3. <u>Ms Emily LAU</u> considered that Members of the Executive Council should not take up chairmanship of the Bills Committee. <u>Mr LEE Cheuk-yan</u> said that the Rules of Procedures and the House Rules of the Legislative Council (LegCo) did not have any specific restriction in this respect. <u>Ms Starry LEE</u> responded that should she be elected as the Chairman of the Bills Committee, she would chair the meeting in a fair and open manner.

- 4. <u>Mr LEE Cheuk-yan</u> asked if there were other nominations. Mr James TO was nominated by <u>Mr Kenneth LEUNG</u> and the nomination was seconded by <u>Ms Emily LAU</u>. <u>Mr James TO</u> accepted the nomination. There was no other nomination.
- 5. Mr LEE Cheuk-yan announced that voting be conducted by secret ballot. After members present had cast their votes, Mr LEE Cheuk-yan invited Mr WONG Ting-kwong and Mr Kenneth LEUNG, who had nominated the two candidates, to monitor the counting of votes. Of the members present, 15 voted for Ms Starry LEE and seven voted for Mr James TO. Mr LEE Cheuk-yan declared that Ms Starry LEE was elected as the Chairman of the Bills Committee. Ms Starry LEE then took the chair.

Election of Deputy Chairman

6. <u>The Chairman</u> called for nominations for the deputy chairmanship of the Bills Committee. Mr James TO was nominated by <u>Mr James TIEN</u> and the nomination was seconded by <u>Mr Kenneth LEUNG</u>. <u>Mr James TO</u> accepted the nomination. There being no other nominations, Mr James TO was declared the Deputy Chairman of the Bills Committee.
