Item No. 2 – FCR(2012-13)54 HEAD 170 – SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT Subhead 000 Operational expenses Subhead 180 Social security allowance scheme

The meeting continued the deliberation on item FCR(2012-13)54 relating to the funding and establishment proposals on the Old Age Living Allowance (OALA).

- 2. <u>Mr WONG Kwok-hing</u> raised a point of order. He said that although members had spent six meetings of some 26 hours in discussing the OALA proposal, a final decision on the agenda item was still nowhere in sight. <u>Mr WONG</u> requested the Chairman to consult members with a view to holding a meeting, on a suitable date in December, with no end time, in order to conclude deliberation on the item. If his suggestion was not acceded to, <u>Mr WONG Kwok-hing</u> asked the Chairman to work out a viable alternative with members to resolve the matter, so that eligible elderly people could receive OALA as early as possible.
- 3. <u>The Chairman</u> commented that Mr WONG Kwok-hing's suggestion did not involve a point of order. He said that he would deal with Mr WONG's request outside the meeting.

(*Post meeting note*: members' views was sought on Mr WONG Kwok-hing's suggestion of whether a meeting with no end time should be held to discuss the OALA proposal vide LC Paper No. FC66/12-13 dated 6 December 2012.)

- 4. <u>The Chairman</u> took turns to put to vote the questions that motions numbered 0422 to 0504 be proceeded forthwith. As requested by members, the division bell was rung for one minute before members voted on individual questions. All questions were voted down by a majority of members.
- 5. At 9:40 pm, the Chairman ordered that the meeting be adjourned.
- 6. The meeting was adjourned at 9:40 pm.
