Action

I. Confirmation of the minutes of the 16th meeting held on 8 February 2013

(LC Paper No. CB(2) 655/12-13)

The minutes were confirmed.

II. Matters arising

Report by the Chairman on his meeting with the Chief Secretary for Administration ("CS")

2. <u>The Chairman</u> informed Members that CS was happy to attend a special House Committee ("HC") meeting and had proposed that it be held on 22 March 2013, from 2:30 pm to 4:00 pm. <u>Members</u> agreed. <u>The Chairman</u> said that in addition to population policy, CS had advised that she was also prepared to answer Members' questions on poverty alleviation and other policy matters at the special meeting.

3. <u>The Chairman</u> further said that he had relayed to CS Members' concern about the lengthy main replies given by some public officers to oral questions at Council meetings. CS had advised that she would remind the Principal Officials to keep the length of their main replies to within seven minutes.

III. Business arising from previous Council meetings

- (a) Legal Service Division reports on bills referred to the House Committee in accordance with Rule 54(4)
 - (i) Trust Law (Amendment) Bill 2013 (LC Paper No. LS 26/12-13)
- 4. At the invitation of the Chairman, <u>Legal Adviser</u> ("LA") explained that the Bill sought to amend the Trustee Ordinance (Cap. 29) and the Perpetuities and Accumulations Ordinance (Cap. 257) to modernize the trust law. The Panel on Financial Affairs was consulted on the legislative proposal on 3 December 2012 and Panel members had expressed various concerns. <u>LA</u> advised that in view of Members' concerns raised at the Panel meeting and the significant implications of the Bill on the trust law in Hong Kong, Members might consider setting up a Bills Committee to study the Bill.
- 5. <u>Mr James TO</u> considered it necessary to form a Bills Committee to study the Bill in detail. <u>Members</u> agreed. Mr James TO and Mr Ronny TONG agreed to join the proposed Bills Committee.
 - (ii) District Councils (Amendment) Bill 2013 (LC Paper No. LS 24/12-13)
- 6. At the invitation of the Chairman, <u>LA</u> said that the purpose of the Bill was to abolish the system of appointing members to the District Councils ("DCs") by the Chief Executive with effect from 1 January 2016, i.e. the commencement date of the fifth term of office of DCs.
- 7. Mr IP Kwok-him considered it necessary to form a Bills Committee to study the Bill in detail. Members agreed. The following Members agreed to join the Bills Committee: Ms Emily LAU, Mr IP Kwok-him, Mr CHAN Han-pan, Mr LEUNG Che-cheung, Miss Alice MAK and Dr Elizabeth QUAT.

(b) Legal Service Division report on subsidiary legislation gazetted on 15 February 2013 and tabled in Council on 20 February 2013

(LC Paper No. LS 25/12-13)

- 8. At the invitation of the Chairman, <u>LA</u> said that one item of subsidiary legislation, i.e. the Dumping at Sea (Exemption) (Amendment) Order 2013 (L.N. 15/2013), was gazetted on 15 February 2013 and tabled in the Council on 20 February 2013.
- 9. <u>Members</u> did not raise any queries on the Order.
- 10. <u>The Chairman</u> reminded Members that the deadline for amending the Order was 20 March 2013.

IV. Business for the Council meeting of 27 February 2013

(a) <u>Tabling of papers</u>

Report No. 11/12-13 of the House Committee on Consideration of Subsidiary Legislation and Other Instruments

(LC Paper No. CB(2) 657/12-13 issued vide LC Paper No. CB(3) 378/12-13 dated 21 February 2013)

- 11. The Chairman said that the Report covered four items of subsidiary legislation, including the Telecommunications (Telecommunications Apparatus) (Exemption from Licensing) (Amendment) Order 2012 (L.N. 190/2012), the period for amendment of which would expire on 27 February 2013. The Chairman further said that as the Chairman of the Subcommittee on the above Order had indicated intention to speak on the Order, he would, in his capacity as Chairman of HC, move a motion at that Council meeting to take note of the Report in relation to the Order after the Financial Secretary ("FS") had delivered his Budget speech.
- (b) **Questions** (*LC Paper No. CB*(3) 373/12-13)
- 12. <u>The Chairman</u> said that 20 written questions had been scheduled for the meeting.
- (c) <u>Bills First Reading and moving of Second Reading</u>
 - (i) the Appropriation Bill 2013; and

(ii) the Estimates of Expenditure for the year ending 31 March 2014

13. <u>The Chairman</u> said that FS would present to the Council on 27 February 2013 the Appropriation Bill 2013 and the Estimates of Expenditure for the year ending 31 March 2014.

V. Position on Bills Committees and subcommittees

(LC Paper No. CB(2) 656/12-13)

14. The Chairman said that as at 21 February 2013, there were three Bills Committees, eight subcommittees under HC (i.e. five subcommittees on subsidiary legislation, one subcommittee on policy issues and two subcommittees on other Council business) and seven subcommittees on policy issues under Panels in action. Three subcommittees on policy issues under Panels were on the waiting list.
