CB(1)727/12-13 and CB(1)733/12-13 respectively on 19 March 2013. The second Subcommittee reported to the House Committee at the meeting on 15 March 2013 vide LC Paper No. CB(1)699/12-13.
- 4. In respect of items (8) and (9), the House Committee considered it not necessary to form any subcommittee to study these items of subsidiary legislation.

Note: Regarding the Import and Export (General) (Amendment) Regulation 2013 (L.N. 25/2013), the Council passed on 20 March 2013 a resolution moved by Hon WONG Ting-kwong, Chairman of the relevant Subcommittee, to extend the scrutiny period of the Regulation to 17 April 2013.
