Dear Mr President,

On behalf of Members of the Legislative Council of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region ("Hong Kong"), I am writing to express our grave concern about Mr Edward Snowden's allegations of hacking into computer systems in Hong Kong by the United States ("US") Administration.

People in Hong Kong are appalled by the alleged surveillance of and intrusion into Hong Kong's communications networks by the US Administration. We denounce any such acts by the US Administration which would undermine the security of the communications networks in Hong Kong and violate the privacy of Hong Kong people.

We demand that the US Administration should give a full account of its surveillance activities on Hong Kong people without further delay. I have written separately to the US Senate and the House of Representatives on the matter.
