Subcommittee Meeting on Legal Aid (Amendment) Regulation 2012, Legal Aid (Assessment of Resources and Contributions) (Amendment) Regulation 2012 and

Legal Aid Ordinance – Resolution of the Legislative Council (Commencement) Notice

The Law Society's Legal Aid Committee ("Committee") welcomes in principle the implementation of the expanded scope of Ordinary Legal Aid Scheme ("OLAS") and Supplementary Legal Aid Scheme ("SLAS") passed by the Legislative Council by way of resolution on 17 July 2012 under Section 7(b) of the Legal Aid Ordinance and the proposed passage of the above subsidiary regulations to facilitate such implementation as a step in the right direction to widen the scope of the existing legal aid scheme.

However, Section 5(16) of the Legal Aid (Assessment of Resources and Contributions) (Amendment) Regulation 2012 provides for, inter alia, the rates of final contribution for all new type of proceedings (except employees claims on appeals from Labour Tribunal) as well as proceedings relating to claims for medical, dental and legal professional negligence (collectively "Claims") at 15% and 20% whereas the rates for other types of proceedings remain at 6% and 10%. The Administration should explain the basis and justification for the much higher rates for the Claims.

Moreover, notwithstanding such expansion, the scope of SLAS still remains restrictive and falls short of the expectation of the public.

After implementation of the aforesaid, the Committee considers that review of the existing legal aid scheme should continue for further expansion in both the scope of services and coverage. Access to justice and equality before the law can be achieved only if the scope and coverage under the existing scheme have been sufficiently widened to meet the unmet needs of the public.

The Committee hereby urges the Administration to continue their review of the legal aid scheme including but not limited to its scope and coverage.
