I. Meeting with the Administration

<u>The Subcommittee</u> deliberated (index of proceedings attached at **Annex**).

Admin 2. <u>Members</u> requested the Administration to -

- (a) consider allowing persons departing from Hong Kong and found carrying small quantity of powdered formula in excess of 1.8 kg to give up the excess quantity at boundary control points;
- (b) provide details on the number of staff deployed to inspect retail outlets for powdered formula in Hong Kong such as pharmacies and major chain retailers to obtain information on the shortage problem in the market, and the respective number of inspections and retail outlets inspected in January and early February 2013 before the Administration came to the conclusion that there was a powdered formula shortage;
- (c) review the drafting of the definition of "powdered formula", having regard to whether it covered rice-based milk cereal;
- (d) advise whether there were any other places imposing restrictions on export of powdered formula;
- (e) provide information on the penalties imposed by the court on persons in breach of the restrictions on articles other than powdered formula listed in Schedule 2 to the Import and Export (General) Regulations (Cap. 60, sub. leg. A) in the past; and
- (f) provide estimates on the monthly/annual consumption of powdered formula by infants and young children in Hong Kong.
- 3. <u>The Administration</u> undertook to review the implementation of the Import and Export (General) (Amendment) Regulation 2013 ("the Amendment Regulation") in one year's time.

II. Date of next meeting

- 4. <u>Members</u> noted that the Chairman would, on behalf of the Subcommittee, move a motion to extend the scrutiny period of the Amendment Regulation to the Council meeting of 17 April 2013. The deadline for giving notice of a motion to amend the Amendment Regulation, if any, at the Council meeting of 17 April 2013 was 10 April 2013. <u>Members</u> also noted that the Chairman would, on behalf of the Subcommittee, make a verbal report on its deliberations to the House Committee on 22 March 2013.
- 5. <u>Members</u> agreed that the next meeting would be held on 25 March 2013 at 2:30 pm to continue discussion with the Administration.
