- 2. <u>Members</u> requested the Administration to provide a written response on whether the products in a list of milk powder products provided by Mr Vincent FANG and tabled at the meeting were subject to regulation under the Import and Export (General) (Amendment) Regulation 2013 ("the Amendment Regulation").
- 3. <u>Mr Dennis KWOK</u> moved the following motion -

"This Subcommittee urges the Government to further amend the definition of "powdered formula" to bring it in line with the policy intent and avoid errors in enforcement."

4. As there were divided views among members, a vote was taken. Six members voted in favour of the motion and six members voted against and one member abstained. The Chairman declared that the motion was negatived.
