**Lighting Intensity of the Video Wall of  
the Kai Tak Cruise Terminal**

Thank you for your letter dated 25 March 2013, referring to us the letter from a Mr Ku dated 19 March 2013 on the captioned matter. Our responses to the issues raised in the letter are as follows -

The video wall of the Kai Tak Cruise Terminal has been equipped with a light sensor. The lighting intensity of the video wall will be varied in accordance with the external lighting condition to achieve a soft effect. The video wall is still under testing, which will be completed before the commissioning of the Kai Tak Cruise Terminal. By that time, the video wall will complement with the overall illumination system of the terminal building, and should blend in well with the surrounding environment. The lighting intensity of the video wall is generally the same as similar video walls currently displayed on both sides of the Victoria Harbour, and should not pose any safety hazard to other vessels and people working on the apron of the terminal.

Upon commissioning of the Kai Tak Cruise Terminal, the video wall will be handed over to the terminal operator for operation and maintenance. The current plan of the terminal operator is to switch off the video wall by

11pm, same as the arrangement for similar video walls on both sides of the Victoria Harbour. We will convey the valuable suggestions of Mr Ku to the terminal operator for reference.
