Dear Sir,

I am writing in full support of the proposed amendments to the Animal Trader Regulation currently under consultation, which if implemented, would rectify the current law in terms of :

1. Providing regulatory supervision for animal welfare protection in line with longstanding international practice which befits a civilized community such as Hong Kong
2. Providing proper health and hygienic supervision on animals kept for breeding, thereby reducing the chance on spread of disease among animals (which may transgress to the human domain through possible mutations)
3. Coupled with proper education on the subject may reduce the incidents on abandoned animals, through casual access to pets being purchased as a commodity without government supervision with a license system
4. Reducing the number of unnecessary / unintentional breeding, hence the amount of unwanted animals in the market / streets.
