## I. Election of Chairman and Deputy Chairman

## Election of Chairman

Mr LEUNG Yiu-chung, the member who had the highest precedence amongst members present at the meeting, presided over the election of Chairman of the Panel for the 2012-2013 session.

- 2. <u>Mr LEUNG Yiu-chung</u> invited nominations for the chairmanship of the Panel. Mr WONG Kwok-hing was nominated by <u>Miss Alice MAK</u> and the nomination was seconded by <u>Mr IP Kwok-him</u>. <u>Mr WONG Kwok-hing</u> accepted the nomination.
- 3. There being no other nominations, Mr WONG Kwok-hing was declared Chairman of the Panel for the 2012-2013 session.

## **Election of Deputy Chairman**

4. <u>Mr WONG Kwok-hing</u> took the chair and invited nominations for the deputy chairmanship. Mr Frederick FUNG was nominated by <u>Mr LEUNG Yiu-chung</u> and the nomination was seconded by <u>Dr Joseph LEE</u>. <u>Mr Frederick FUNG</u> accepted the nomination. There being no other nominations, Mr Frederick FUNG was declared Deputy Chairman of the Panel for the 2012-2013 session.

## II. Schedule of meetings for the 2012-2013 session

- 5. <u>Members</u> noted the proposed schedule of regular meetings of the Panel for the 2012-2013 session, which was tabled at the meeting.
- 6. <u>Members</u> agreed that all meetings of the Panel would be held on the first Monday of each month at 2:30 pm, except for the following
  - (a) the meeting in April 2013 would be held on Monday, 15 April 2013, at 8:30 am; and
  - (b) the meeting in July 2013 would be held on Tuesday, 2 July 2013, at 4:30 pm.

(*Post-meeting note*: The meeting schedule for the 2012-2013 session was circulated to members vide LC Paper No. CB(1)38/12-13 on 17 October 2012.)

# III. Items for discussion at next meeting

- 7. <u>Members</u> noted the Administration's proposal to brief members on the short to medium term housing and land supply measures announced by the Chief Executive on 30 August 2012 at a joint meeting with the Panel on Development on Monday, 5 November 2012 from 2:30 pm to 4:00 pm, to be followed by the regular meeting of the Panel on Housing in the same afternoon.
- 8. Mr Abraham SHEK said that at an earlier meeting of the Panel on Development, some members had requested that more time should be devoted to discussing the subject, or alternatively, separate meetings should be held by the two Panels. He suggested that the Chairmen of the Panel on

Housing and the Panel on Development should work out an acceptable arrangement.

9. <u>Dr Fernando CHEUNG</u> shared the view that more time should be allowed for discussing this important subject. He also urged the Administration to provide information papers for members' reference early. He pointed out that the Administration should respect members by providing relevant information to members first before briefing the media on important matters, instead of the other way round as in some past cases. He said that it might be necessary for the Chairmen of the two Panels to take up the matter with the Chairman of the House Committee. The <u>Chairman</u> undertook to liaise with the Chairman of the Panel on Development on the arrangements for the joint meeting.

(*Post-meeting note:* With the concurrence of the Chairman, the next regular meeting of the Panel would be held on Monday, 5 November 2012 from 2:30 pm to 4:30 pm to discuss the following items -

- (a) Extending the Home Ownership Scheme secondary market to white form buyers; and
- (b) Long Term Housing Strategy.

As for the joint meeting with the Panel on Development to discuss the "Short to medium term housing and land supply measures announced by the Chief Executive on 30 August 2012", it was agreed that a three-hour meeting would be held on Friday, 9 November 2012 at 9:30 am to discuss the subject.)

- 10. Referring to the "List of issues suggested to be considered" tabled at the meeting, <u>members</u> agreed to include the following additional items to the list for future discussion by the Panel -
  - (a) Measures to deal with subdivided flats Mr LEUNG Yiu-chung, Mr LEUNG Kwok-hung and Dr Fernando CHEUNG were concerned about the problems associated with subdivided flats in private developments, industrial buildings as well as shopping arcade. They considered that measures should be worked out to tackle the situation; and
  - (b) Overcrowding relief in public rental housing Mr Christopher CHUNG requested the Administration to conduct a review on

the policy on overcrowding relief in public rental housing to ensure equity in allocation standards.
