## Revision of Fees under Entertainment Special Effects (Fees) Regulation

#### **PURPOSE**

This paper outlines the Administration's proposal to revise the fees prescribed in the Entertainment Special Effects (Fees) Regulation (ESE(F)R), which is a piece of subsidiary legislation of the Entertainment Special Effects Ordinance (ESEO) (Cap. 560).

#### **BACKGROUND**

- 2. The ESEO provides for the regulation of the supply, use, conveyance and storage of special effects materials for and incidental to the production of special effects in film production, entertainment programmes and performances, and other related matters. The Head of Create Hong Kong is the Entertainment Special Effects Licensing Authority by virtue of section 3 of the ESEO.
- 3. Sections 26(1)(n) and 26(1)(o) of the ESEO stipulate that the Entertainment Special Effects Licensing Authority (ESELA) may, with the approval of the Secretary for Commerce and Economic Development, by regulation provide for fees payable in respect of
  - (a) any examination or assessment that may be required for the issue or alteration of a special effects operator licence; and
  - (b) the issue, renewal, certification, replacement or alteration of any licence and permit.

The existing fees prescribed in the ESE(F)R have been in force since June 2005.

#### PROPOSED FEES REVISION

4. It is government policy that fees charged by the Government for various services should in general be set at levels sufficient to recover the full costs of providing the services. Based on the outcome of a costing exercise conducted by Create Hong Kong to review the fees prescribed in the ESE(F)R, we propose to increase the fees by 5.5% to 8.3% so as to achieve full cost recovery. The existing and proposed fees are set out at **Annex**.

Annex

- 5. The proposed increase in the fees is mainly attributable to the increase in staff cost despite the streamlining of procedures for processing the licence and permit applications. Create Hong Kong will continue to pursue initiatives to improve efficiency and lower costs.
- 6. Given that the proposed fee adjustments are not significant in dollar terms, we expect that they will have little impact on business operating costs of the film and entertainment sectors concerned.

#### FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

7. If the proposed fee revision is implemented, the estimated increase in revenue is about \$80,000 per annum. The proposal has no staffing implications.

#### IMPLEMENTATION TIMETABLE

8. We will gazette and table the Entertainment Special Effects (Fees) (Amendment) Regulation at the Legislative Council in February 2013. We propose that the revision of fees take effect in April 2013 upon completion of the negative vetting period on the subsidiary legislation.

### **WAY FORWARD**

9. Members are invited to note the proposed revision of fees. We will proceed with the necessary legislative amendments to implement the revised fees.
