Explanatory Note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the Public Health and Municipal Services (Fees and Charges) (Leisure Facilities) Regulation (Cap. 132 sub. leg. CN) to provide for the fee payable by an individual as a member of the public—

- (a) as the fee for a single entry into a public swimming pool;
- (b) as the fee for the hire of a tennis court, basketball court, squash court, football pitch, table tennis table or badminton court in a public pleasure ground; and
- (c) as the camp fee for a holiday camp on a public pleasure ground.
