Frozen Confections (Amendment) Regulation 2013

(Made by the Secretary for Food and Health under section 124I of the Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Cap. 132) and section 9 of the Provision of Municipal Services (Reorganization) Ordinance (Cap. 552))

1. Commencement

This Regulation comes into operation on 19 July 2013.

2. Frozen Confections Regulation amended

Explanatory Note

The object of this Regulation is to amend section 40(2A) of the Frozen Confections Regulation (Cap. 132 sub. leg. AC). The amendment is consequential to the making of the Public Health and Municipal Services (Fees) (Amendment) Regulation 2013 (L.N. 84 of 2013) which provides for, among other things, the fee for the grant or renewal of a provisional licence for the manufacture of frozen confections.
