Bills Committee on Administration of Justice (Miscellaneous Provisions) Bill 2014

Thank you for the email of 17 July 2014, relaying a submission from the Labour Advisory Board to the Bills Committee. I set out our response in the ensuing paragraphs.

I. <u>Security for awards and orders</u>

Similar to other orders made by the Tribunal, a party who is dissatisfied with an order to give security may apply to the Court of First Instance for leave to appeal as currently provided under section 32(1) of the Labour Tribunal Ordinance (Cap 25).

II. Provisions relating to disclosure of documents

As suggested by the LegCo Panel on Administration of Justice and Legal Services in January 2014 when examining the captioned Bill, we have already taken out from the Bill the proposed amendments relating to disclosure of documents.

We will also relay the above response to the Labour Advisory Board separately.
